5,6% of France's GDP is spent on education (OECD average is 5.2%)

Government support tuition fees: resulting “reasonable rates”

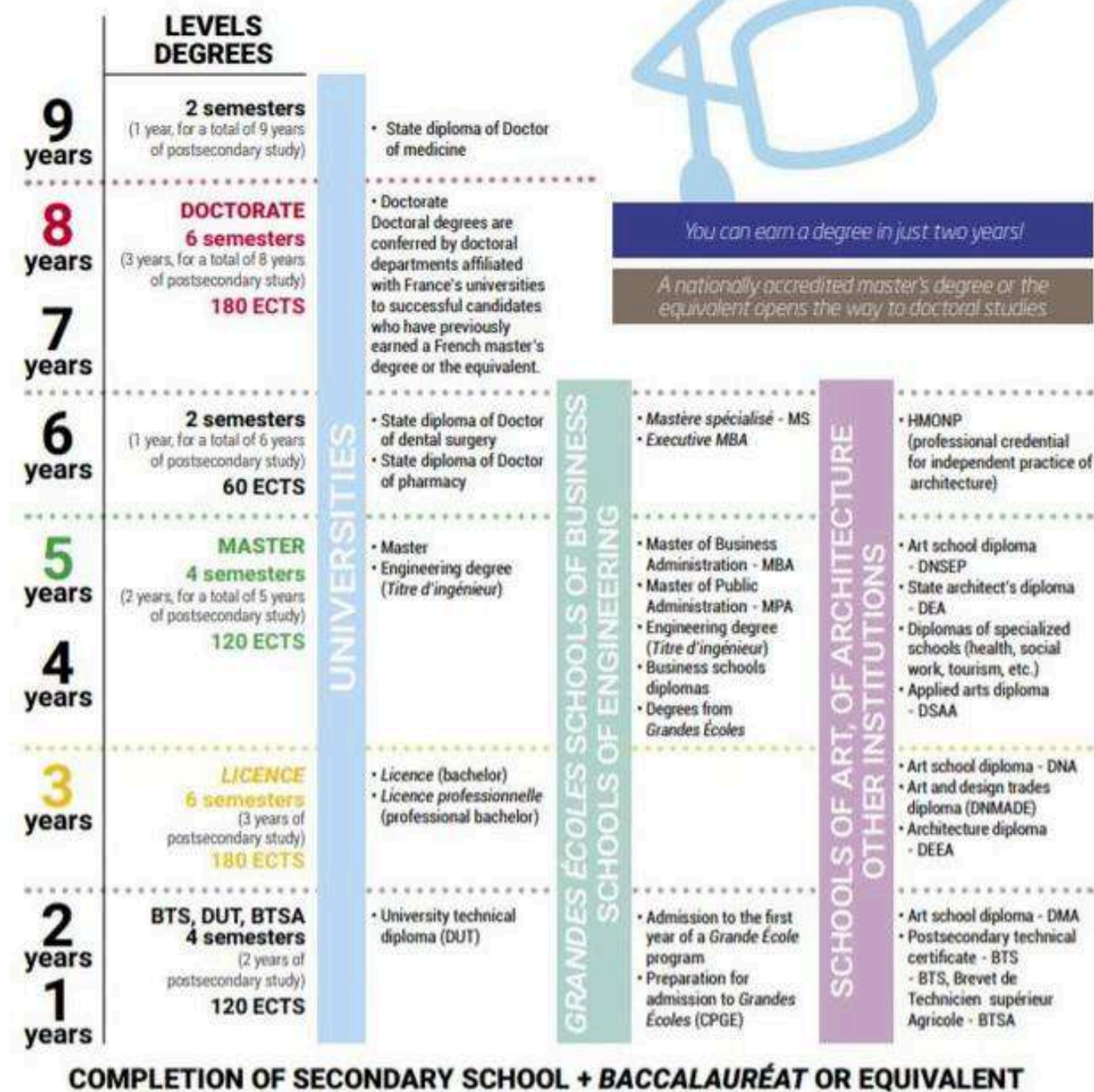

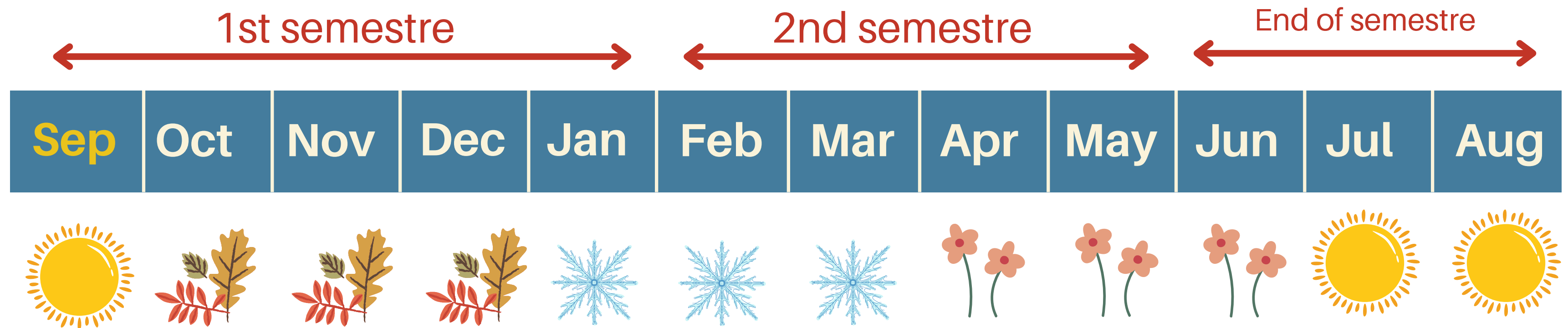


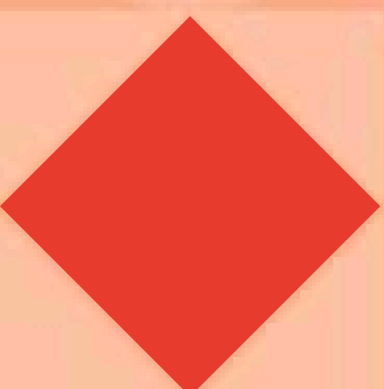
National and International recognition of French Diplomas

What is the cost of life in France?

To live in France, you must have a monthly budget of 700 to 900 Euros and the cost of living can be fairly high to 1,000-1,500 Euros, especially in Paris and the big cities to cover food, transport, healthcare, entertainment and housing expenses.

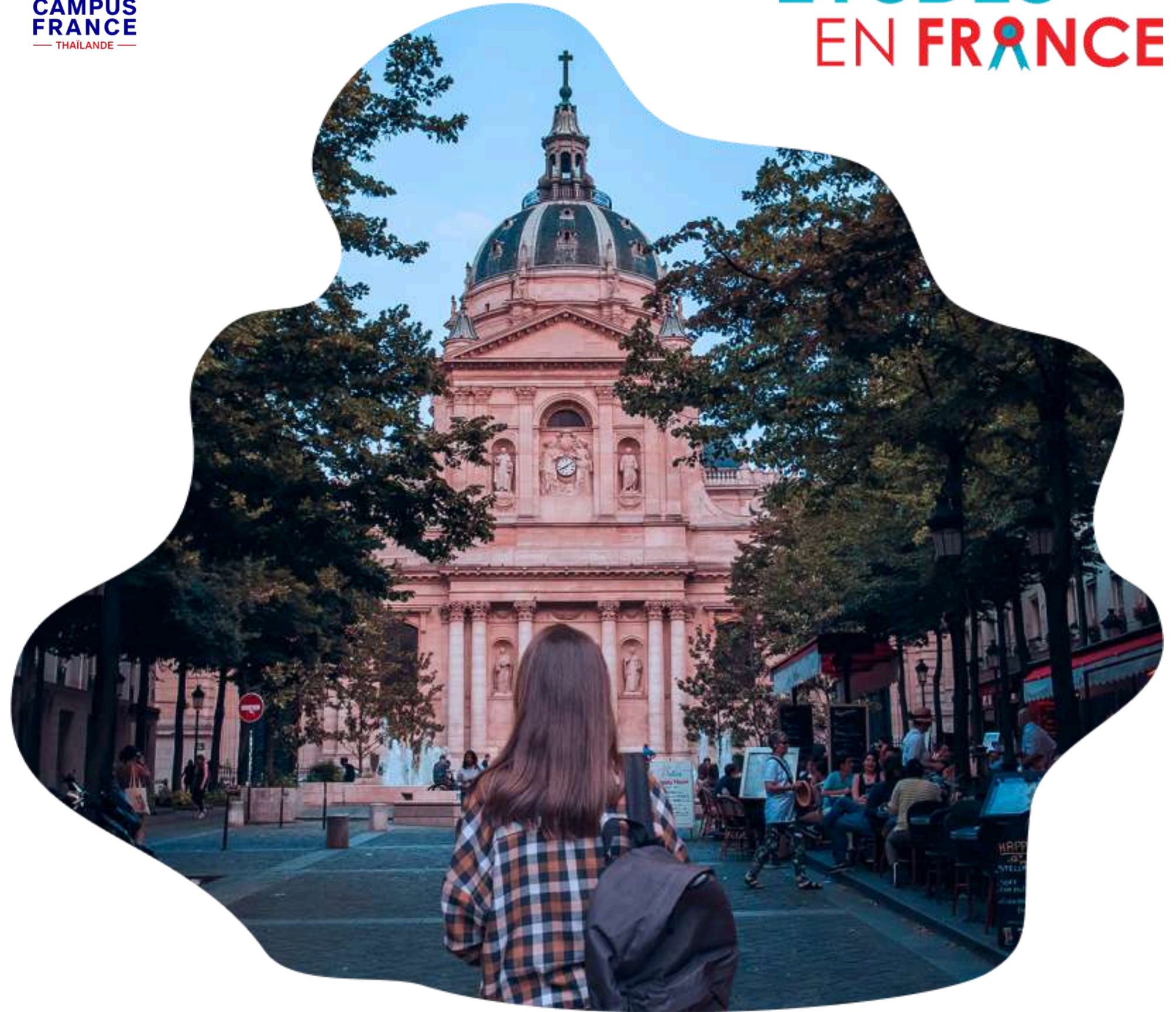

The new process to study in France

Etudes en France is a comprehensive **online platform that manages all of the enrollment procedures to higher education institutions in France up until the visa request.** To simplify the application process for international students with one common application, international candidates can apply to several higher education programs in France with the assistance of Campus France Thailand agents.

2 APPLICATION TYPES

Pre-consular

- For applicants who have already received an acceptance letter from the institute and planned to study in France for more than 90 days
- Can be applied throughout the year



Candidature

- For DAP and HDAP applicants
- **DAP : 1 October - 15 December**
HDAP : 1 October 2024 - 28 February 2025



6 APPLICANT TYPES

Candidature

DAP

- Those who apply for the first year of Bachelor degree (Licence 1), PACES (the first year of Medical school) or every Art and Architectural program
- Up to 3 courses can be applied



HDAP

- Those who apply for the second (Licence 2) or third year of Bachelor degree (Licence 3), or Master degree
- Up to 7 courses can be applied



Study abroad/Exchange/ Dual-degree

- Those who are now study in the university which has MOU contract with the university in France, and want to join the exchange program



Independent

- Those who apply for courses which are not considered as a degree (e.g. cooking course, language course, etc.)



HDAP Allégé

- Those who apply directly with the institute in France for the second or third year of Bachelor degree or Master degree, and have already got accepted



PhD Student

- Those who apply for Doctorate degree directly with the institute in France
