

Details of Application for ASEAN University Network (AUN) Summer Camp 2025 (1st Batch)

1. General Qualification of Applicants

- 1) Being an undergraduate student at Prince of Songkla University, with the status of currently studying in the 2nd year or above.
- 2) Have an interest in social contexts and SDGs.
- 3) Possess good English communication skills.
- 4) Not be under suspension or any disciplinary penalty.
- 5) Demonstrate leadership, confidence, adaptability, and responsibility.
- 6) Be physically and mentally fit without any severe communicable diseases.
- 7) Must not have previously participated in the AUN Summer Camp program.

2. Selection Process

PSU will evaluate and select applicants based on the qualifications, the number of participants, and the conditions specified by the host university, as well as other relevant criteria.

3. Program Conditions

3.1) Selected students must participate in the program as specified by the host university. This requires obtaining consent from their guardian/advisor/chair of program and requesting their affiliated faculty/campus to facilitate the student's round-trip travel arrangements.

3.2) Non-participation Penalty: If an awardee cannot attend the entire program as specified, they must return all financial support unless in cases of unforeseen circumstances (e.g., sudden illness, natural disasters, accidents, political unrest, or epidemics). Faculties/campuses must submit a written explanation to the Global Affairs and Corporate Communication Center for consideration.

3.3) The awardees must submit a participation report within 30 days after the program ends. Faculties should compile and forward these reports to the Global Affairs and Corporate Communication Center, which will issue e-certificates to awardees.

3.4) After completing the program and prior to graduation, students are required to take the online course titled "071-N03 Exploring World: Culture Life Business and Sustainability Insights for New Generation" offered by the Global Affairs and Corporate Communication Center through PSU Next-U. Upon completion, please attach evidence of your online certificate and send it via email to psu-international@psu.ac.th

4. Expenses & Support

4.1 Covered by Host University:

- Accommodation
- Meals
- Local transportation
- Other provisions as determined by the host university

4.2 Covered by PSU (actual reimbursement not exceed 25,000 Baht):

- Transportation costs for domestic and international round-trip travel
- International travel insurance (coverage during the program duration)

4.3 Participant's Responsibility:

- Personal expenses and other costs beyond the coverage mentioned above.

5. Required Application Documents

- 1) Completed application form (attached to the announcement).
- 2) One 2-inch photo.
- 3) PSU transcript (Download via <https://sis.psu.ac.th/>)
- 4) Resume/Curriculum Vitae.

- 5) Copy of passport (valid throughout the entire duration of the activities in the host university's country, for no less than 6 months)
- 6) Proof of English language proficiency (if applicable)
- 7) Track record of leadership roles and/or contribution to community service (if applicable).
- 8) A statement in Microsoft Word format, Times New Roman, font size 13, not exceeding 300 words: Specify your interests, experiences, or motivations for participating, aligning with the topics set by the host university.

6. Application Process and Timeline

Date	Activity
21 March – 2 April 2025	Submit complete application and required documents in PDF via email to psu-international@psu.ac.th within the specified deadline For original documents, submit them through the affiliated faculty, which will then forward them to the Global Affairs and Corporate Communication Center.
4 April 2025	Announcement of shortlisted candidates
8 April 2025	The selection process will be conducted as follows: - Students from Hat Yai/Pattani Campus: At Meeting Room 211, 2 nd Floor, President's Office, Hat Yai Campus. - Students from Phuket/Surat Thani/Trang Campus: Via an online program. <u>Remarks:</u> 1. The selection criteria will follow the decision of the committee, which is considered final. 2. For students from Pattani Campus, the International Relations Office of the faculty/central office is requested to arrange transportation for students to attend the interview at Hat Yai Campus.
9 April 2025	Announcement of Awardees (1 st Batch)
10 April 2025 onwards	Submission of nominated students to host universities and awardees are required to register through the host university's system.
Late April – July 2025	Disbursement of financial support/ letter of consent/ participation report and others will be sent to affiliated faculty.
2 weeks prior to departure	Faculties assist with outbound travel approvals for nominated students through https://io-student.psu.ac.th/ and other arrangements.
May – September 2025	Participation in the host universities' programs.
