The Rong Chang Cup Youth Innovation Competition on Global Governance (YICGG) is the world's first international innovation contest in the realm of global governance, independently founded by Chinese university students. First launched in 2007 by Fudan University, it has been supported by the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) in China and the Shanghai Rong Chang Public Welfare Foundation, and is organized by the School of International Relations and Public Affairs of Fudan University. Over the past 17 years, YICGG has brought together more than 2,940 young participants from across the globe to discuss and debate global affairs, fostering communication and exploring possibilities for the future of human development.

This year, YICGG2025 commemorates **the 80th anniversary of the establishment of the United Nations as well as the 120th anniversary of the founding of Fudan University**. In alignment with these milestones, **YICGG2025 explores the theme 'AI for Peace'**, inviting young innovators to engage in discussions on how artificial intelligence can contribute to global stability and development.

The final round of YICGG2025 is scheduled to take place **from July 23rd to July 29th in Shanghai and Beijing, China**. The YICGG committee will provide one-way tickets to Shanghai for all selected candidates, as well as cover accommodation, local transportation, and certain meals during the final competition.
