







 maximum amount per grant shall not exceed 100,000 THB

## **Application Qualifications**

- For Ph.D. and Master degree in thesisbased plan
- Research is related to problem solving in the community within Southern Thailand

#### Terms and Conditions

- Must submit the research output that has been disseminated to the community, along with a certification letter from the community, and provide a copy of the dissemination to the Graduate School for approval.
- Must submit evidence of grant reimbursement to the faculty before graduation and/or within two fiscal years of receiving the grant for verification.

## Number of scholarship

• 35 grants per year

#### Scholarship value

• 30,000/ Grant

#### **Scholarship** duration

• Total 10 months

The duration may be less in case of graduation.

#### **Conditions**

- Must perform work related to academics in course of study for 30 hours per month, including:
- Working as a teaching assistant or lecturer at the Bachelor's degree level
- Assisting in checking practical work and reports at the Bachelor's degree level
- Other tasks assigned by the program chairperson


