Credit

Grade	Definition	Attached point (per credit)
A	Excellent	4.0
B+	Very good	3.5
B	Good	3.0
C+	Fairly good	2.5
C	Fair	2.0
D+	Poor	1.5
D	Very poor	1.0
E	Fail	0

If students earn 'D+', 'D' or 'E' ?

Audit

S	Satisfactory
U	Unsatisfactory

For courses such as internship and cooperative study

G	Distinction
P	Pass
F	Fail

Other symbols

“W” (Withdrawn)

means course withdrawal or cancellation

“I” (Incomplete)

means incomplete assessment, and shall be used when a course instructor, has decided that the evaluation and assessment must be postponed due to students' incomplete assignments considered to be parts of the course.

Academic Status

“Pass” represents the academic status of students whose GPA is no less than 2.00.

“Critical” represents the academic status of students whose GPA is between 1.00 and 1.99 in the first semester of study at the University.

“Probation” represents the academic status of students whose GPA is less than 2.00.

Academic Status

First probation:

- Students studying in the University for the first two semesters who earn a grade point average of 1.25 or above, but lower than 2.00, or
- Students with a 'pass' status who earn a grade point average of 1.50 or above, but lower than 2.00 in the following regular semester.

Second probation:

- Students with "First Probation" who earn a GPA of 1.70 or above, but lower than 2.00, in the following semester.

Third probation:


- Students with "Second Probation" who earn a GPA of 1.90 or above, but lower than 2.00 in the following semester

Grading system and Student Status

Academic Status

Example 1


Year/Semester	Grade point average (GPA)	Status
1 st Year	< 1.00	Retired
First Semester	1.00 - 1.99	Critical
1 st Year	< 1.25	Retired
Second Semester	1.25 - 1.99	1 st Probation
2 nd Year	< 1.70	Retired
First Semester	1.70 - 1.99	2 nd Probation
2 nd Year	< 1.90	Retired
Second Semester	1.90 - 1.99	3 rd Probation



Academic Status

Example 2

Year/Semester	Grade point average (GPA)	Status
1 st Year First Semester	2.00	Pass
1 st Year Second Semester	2.00	Pass
2 nd Year First Semester	< 1.50	Retired
	1.50-1.99	1 st Probation



Graduation Requirements

- ▶ Completed and passed all the courses and requirements of the program for which students have studied, without “I”, including equated and transferred courses.
- ▶ Having student status as ‘pass’, with a minimum GPA not less than 2.00.
- ▶ Passed extra-curricular activities for student development stipulated in the University Announcements.

Graduation Requirements

- ▶ Passed competency and/or skills tests in an accordance with the University Announcements. “ English Exit Exam”
- ▶ Must not be in a measure for an awaiting punishment period of any disciplinary penalties.
- ▶ Not owing any debt to the University
