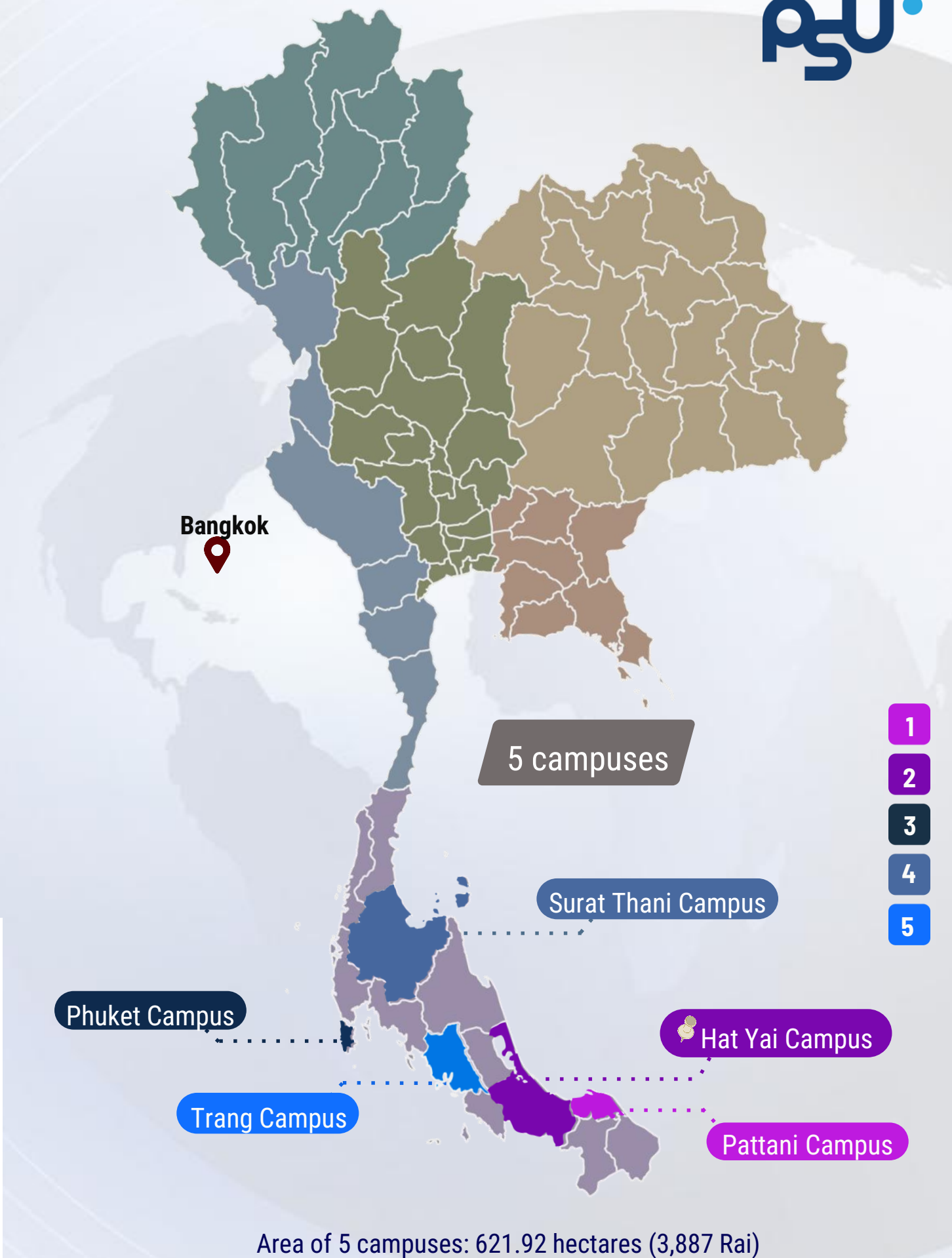

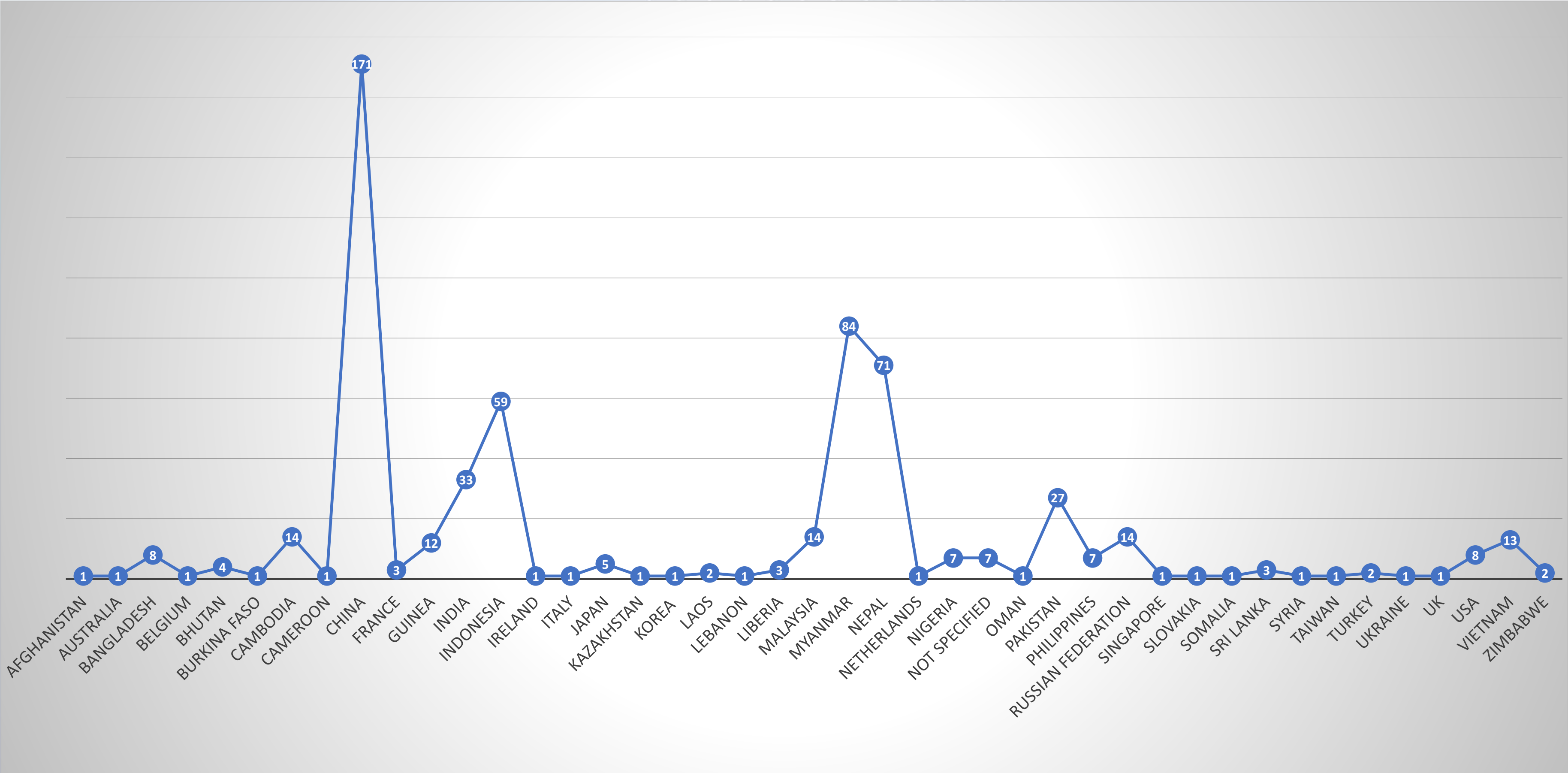

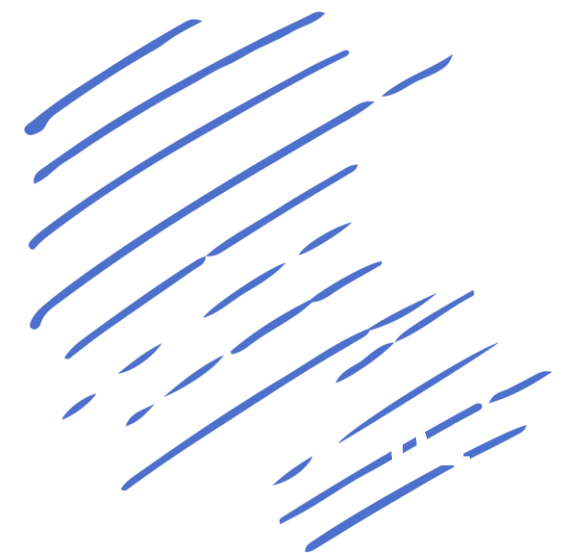
PSU Current International Student Enrollment by Nationality

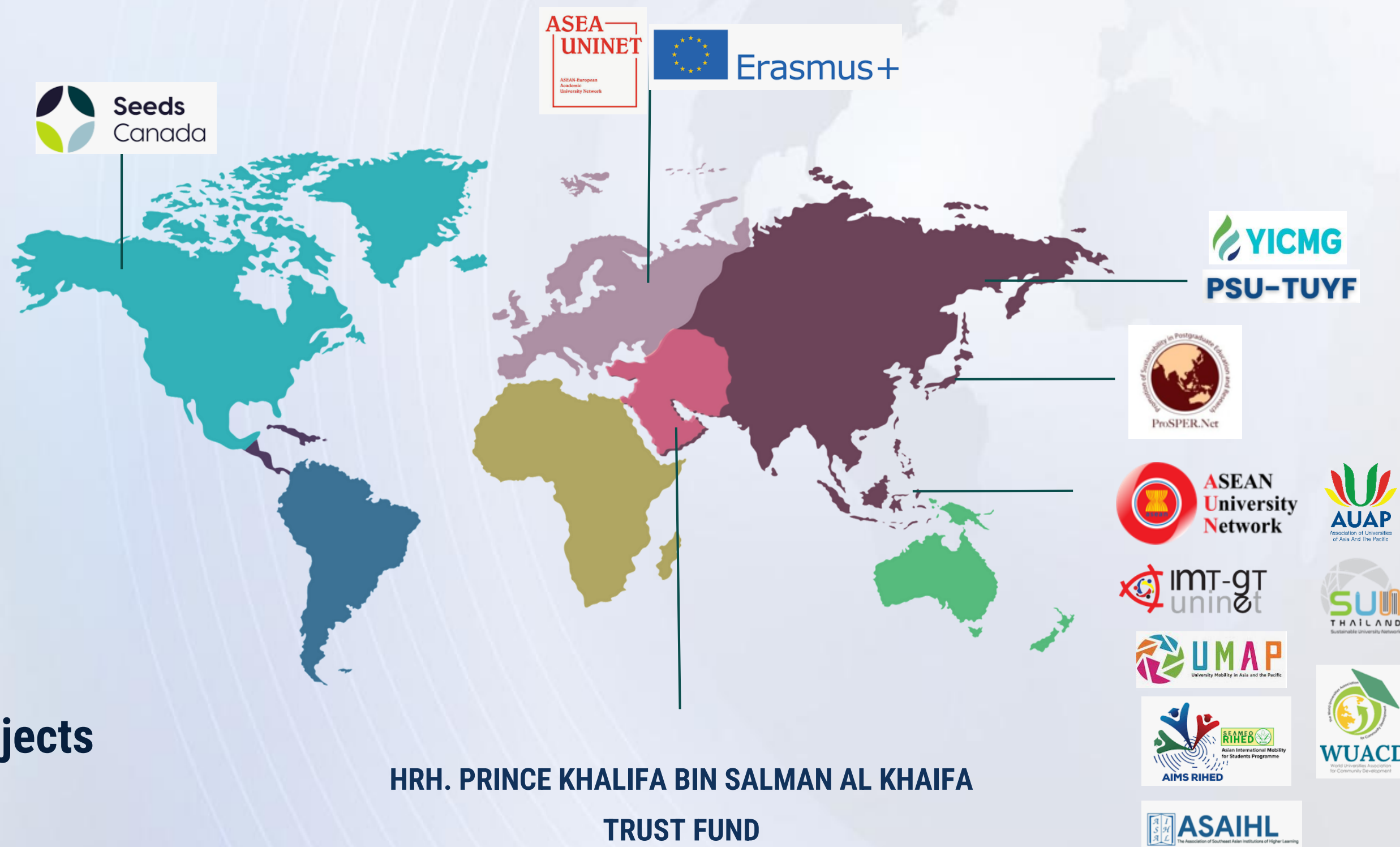
