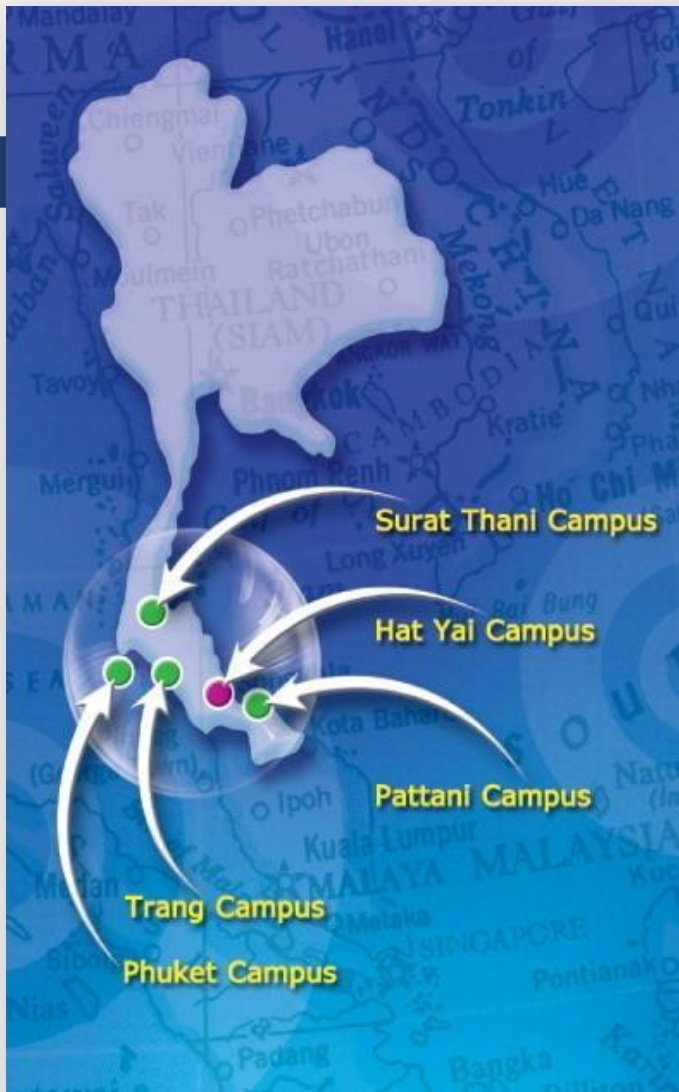

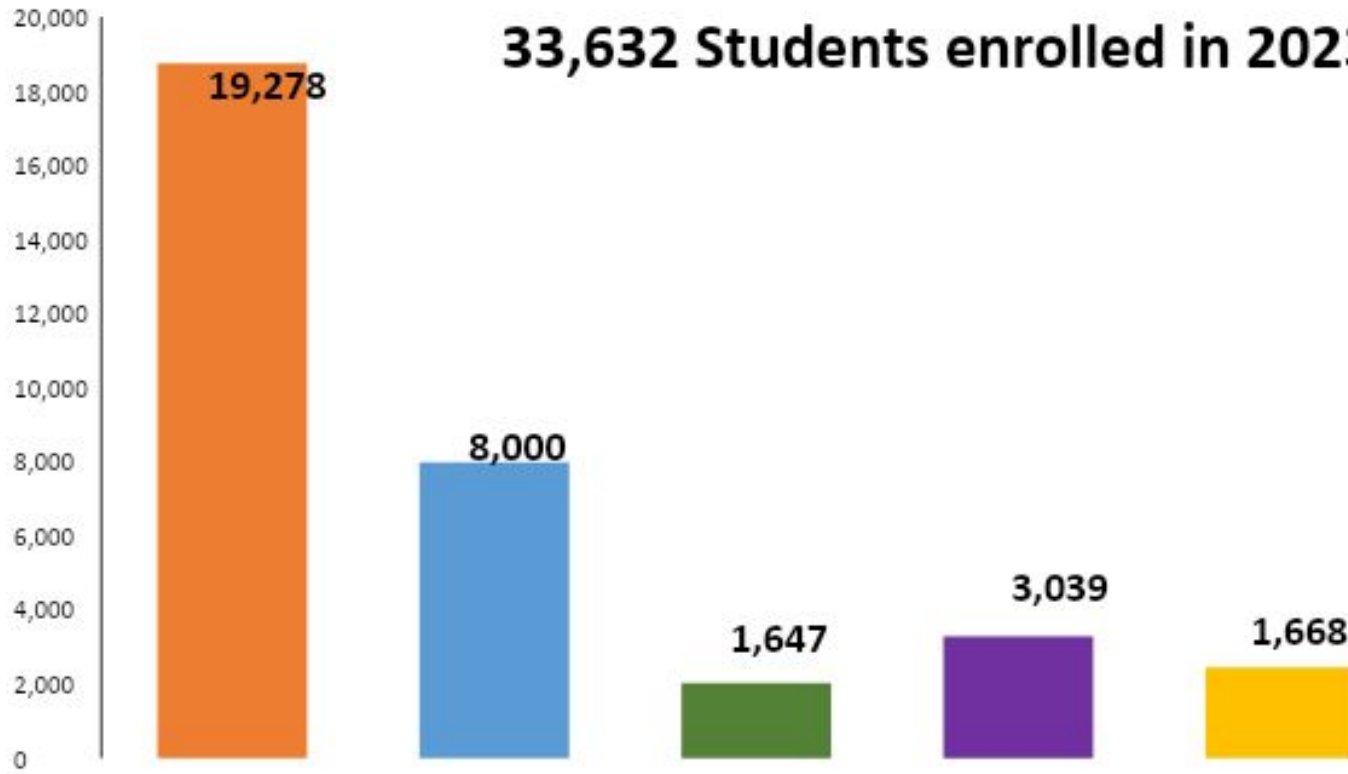

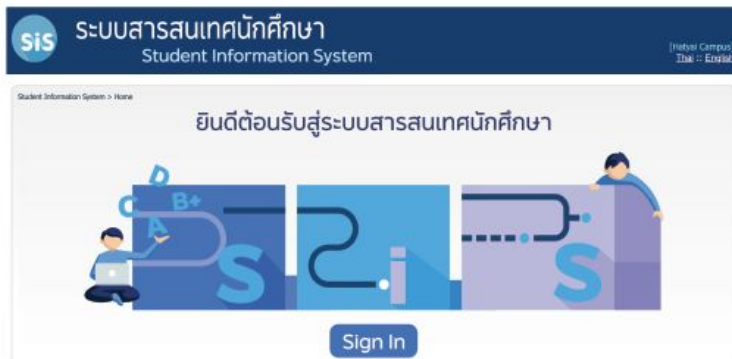

Getting ready for classes:

PSU Student Information System



PSU uses an internet-based system for managing student records called **Student Information System (SIS)**. You will use SIS to register for courses, but first you will have to receive a PSU Passport from your faculty. Once you arrive at PSU, the faculty will contact the Registrar's Office.

Through this Passport you will have access to the university's student system, where you can find your classes schedule, financial records, transcript and other important information regarding your study at PSU.

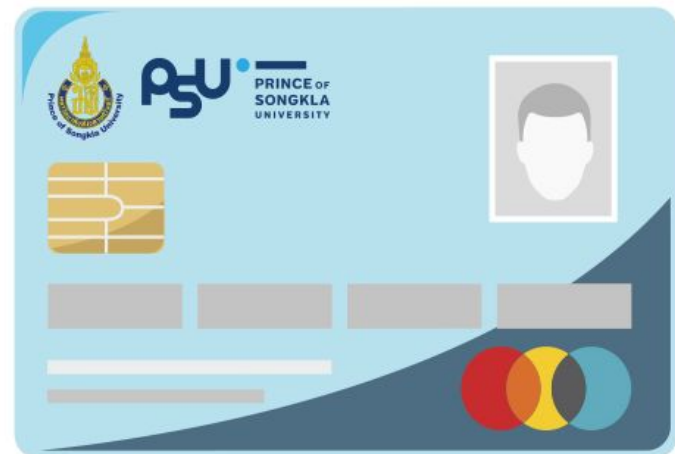

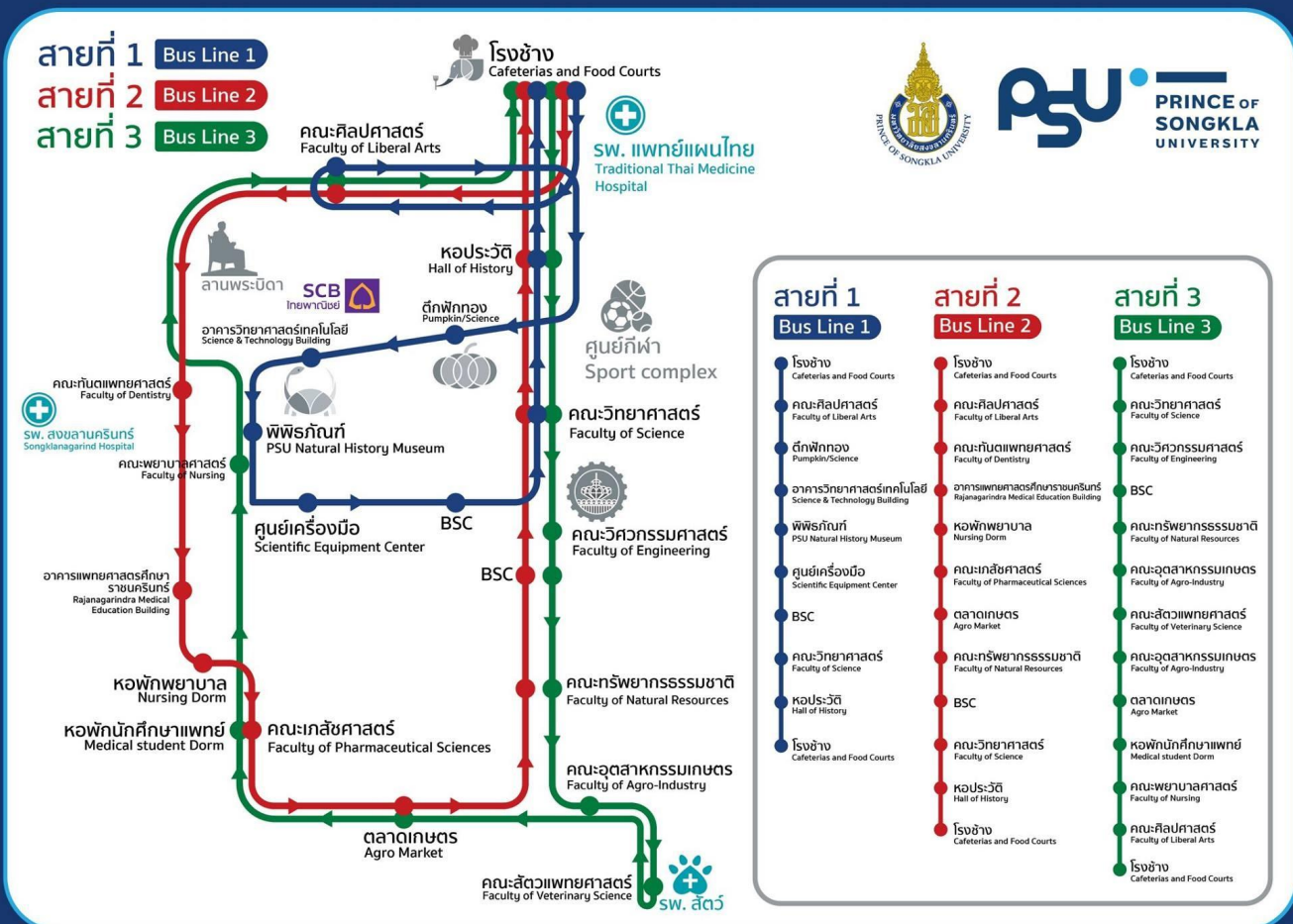

Guidance for Immigration Procedures



The PSU International Student & Staff Office offers assistance and guidance to PSU foreign students and staff regarding a variety of immigration affairs such as:

- **Notification of Residence**
- **One-year Visa Extension**
- **Re-entry Permit**
- **90-day Report and**
- **other immigration-related issues**

Notification of Residence (housing notification)



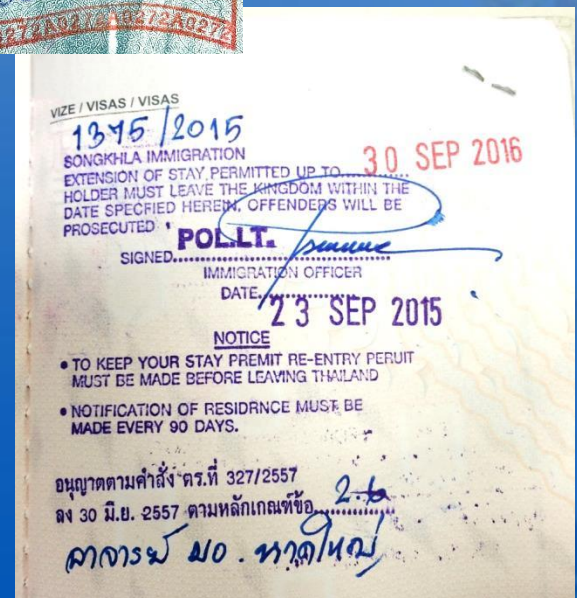
PSU foreign students must notify their residence ("Notification for Owner of Residence where Alien has Stayed" / TM. 30) to local immigration authorities:

- within 24 hours after the 1st arrival in Thailand, and
 - if the address to return to in Thailand changes: after re-entering Thailand from abroad (coming back from a trip abroad), and after returning from a trip to other provinces inside Thailand
-
- Students **staying at PSU International Dormitories**, must notify the Division of Student Development and Alumni to do this notification online.
 - For foreigners **staying outside the campus**, the owner of the apartment / landlord must fill in the TM. 30 form and provide a copy of his/her national ID card and a copy of the house registration book, both signed by the owner.
 - Please attach to the TM. 30 form the copies of your **full passport, current visa and departure card** (if any).
 - Upon notification, foreigners will receive a **Receipt of Notification**. This receipt must be presented for the one-year visa extension.

One-year Visa Extension for Students

- A foreign student must enter Thailand with a Non-immigrant “ED” visa, obtained from the Royal Thai Embassy / Consulate in his/her country. The validity of this visa is **three months** and
- once in Thailand, student can apply for the extension of stay for one year at the related Immigration Office in Thailand **before the expiry date** mentioned on the visa.
- after receiving the extension: **check** that the extension date is correct
- the last visa extension could be shorter than one year, depending on student’s graduation date.

*Faculty staff must accompany the foreign student to the Immigration Office for visa extension.



90-day Report



- a foreigner staying in Thailand for a period longer than 90 days and holding a Non-Immigrant Visa, is required by the Thai Immigration to report the current address every 90 days;
- he /she must file this report within **15 days before or 7 days after** the 90-day-period expires;
- however, if he /she leaves Thailand anytime during the 90-day period, then the day-count will restart from one upon the re-entry date into Thailand.

Re-entry Permit



- foreign students and staff holding a single entry visa or an extension of stay and planning to travel abroad, must obtain a **Re-entry Permit** before their departure, otherwise their visa will be invalidated and they will have to go through the whole process of getting the proper visa at a Thai Embassy or Consulate outside Thailand.
- the Re-entry Permit must be obtained from the Immigration Office before leaving Thailand

Important for Immigration Procedures



- check well the expiry date of your **One-year Visa Extension**: one can submit the documents not more than 45 days in advance. If the one-year visa expires, there is a fine of 500 Baht per day, but not exceeding 20,000 Baht in total. A ban from entering the country for a certain number of days may also be applied.
- for the **90-day Report**, one can submit the documents even 15 days in advance or 7 days after the expiry date; if later, he/she will be fined 2,000-5,000 Baht.
- be sure that you obtained a **Re-entry Permit** before travelling abroad / exiting Thailand; otherwise, your One-year Visa will be invalidated.
- remember to do the housing notification (TM. 30) 24 hours after coming back from a trip abroad or from other provinces inside Thailand if your address in Thailand has changed; the **Receipt of Notification** must be presented for the visa extension.



Warning of overstay



The aliens overstaying the kingdom of Thailand for a long period will be banned from re-entering the country as follows ;

In case of alien surrendering to the authorities

Period of overstay	Period of banning from re-entering the country (starting from the departure date)
more than 90 days	1 year
more than 1 year	3 years
more than 3 years	5 years
more than 5 years	10 years

In case of alien being arrested and prosecuted

Period of overstay	Period of banning from re-entering the country (starting from the departure date)
less than or 1 year	5 years
more than 1 year	10 years

This order will be enforced on 20 March 2016.
