- [khráp] (male speaker) polite ending particle used when asking a question, making a statement and showing that one is listening

# Sentence patterns

[chán khǒɔ kûŋ thǒt khâ?]

(female speaker)

I'd like deep fried shrimp.

I'll have deep fried shrimp.

[chán ʔaw plaa jâaŋ khâ?]

(female speaker)

I'd like grilled fish.

I'll have grilled fish.



[phǒm khǒɔ khâaw sǔaj kàp khàj-ciaw khráp]

(male speaker)

I'd like steamed rice and omelet.

I'll have steamed rice and omelet.

[phǒm ʔaw khâaw tòm kàp mǔu thǒt khráp]

(male speaker)

I'd like soft-boiled rice and fried pork.

I'll have soft-boiled rice and fried pork.
